Creates two funds to help colleges and technical schools pay for assets, improvements and repairs.			
Proposition 2	Capital Gains Tax Ban	SJR 18	<input type="checkbox"/> No
Amendment bans any future state tax on personal wealth, assets, or net worth.			
Proposition 3	Bail Reform	SJR 5	<input type="checkbox"/> No
Allow judges to deny bail under specific circumstances, including violent offenses, sexual offenses, etc.			
Proposition 4	Water Infrastructure	HJR 7	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Yes
Amendment dedicating sales tax revenue to the Water Fund for reliable access, growth, and sustainability.			
Proposition 5	Feed Tax Exemption	HJR 99	<input type="checkbox"/> No
Proposition would allow the legislature to exempt animal feed held for retail sale from property taxation.			
Proposition 6	Securities Tax Ban	HJR 4	<input type="checkbox"/> No
Amendment bans future taxes on securities transactions and occupation taxes on market operators.			
Proposition 7	Veteran Spouse Tax Relief	HJR 133	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Yes
Authorizes property tax exemption to spouses of veterans who have died from service-related conditions.			
Proposition 8	Death Tax Ban	HJR 2	<input type="checkbox"/> No
Prohibits the state from imposing taxes on property transfers such as estate, inheritances, and death taxes.			
Proposition 9	Business Property Tax Relief	HJR 1	<input type="checkbox"/> No
Exempts property taxation on up to \$250,000 of tangible personal property used for income production.			
Proposition 10	Disaster Relief	SJR 84	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Yes
Allows Legislature to grant temporary property tax exemption for homesteads that are destroyed by fire.			
Proposition 11	Senior/Disabled Tax Relief	SJR 85	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Yes
Raises homestead tax exemption from \$10,000 to up to \$60,000 for the elderly and disabled homeowners.			
Proposition 12	Judicial Oversight	SJR 27	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Yes
Reforms judicial oversight with citizen oversight, power to discipline judges, and transparency and fairness.			
Proposition 13	Homestead Exemption	SJR 2	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Yes
Proposal to raise the homestead exemption for school taxes from \$100,000 to \$140,000 in taxable market value.			
Proposition 14	Dementia Research	SJR 3	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Yes
Allocates \$3B for an institute and funding into dementia, Alzheimer's, Parkinson's disease, etc.			
Proposition 15	Parental Rights	SJR 34	<input type="checkbox"/> No
Amendment affirms parents' rights to raise their children, limiting government interference.			
Proposition 16	Citizenship Voting	SJR 37	<input type="checkbox"/> No
Amends Constitution so that only U.S. citizens may vote in any Texas election (state, local, and municipal).			
Proposition 17	Border Infrastructure	HJR 34	<input type="checkbox"/> No
Exempts property in counties bordering Mexico from taxation due to border security infrastructure.
